


Changing Your PIN

1. After your first required PIN change via the VRU, you may change your PIN again. Simply call the Voice Response Unit (VRU) and follow the prompts to change PIN.
2. You can also login to www.cumoney.com and select **Change PIN**. You will be required to enter your old PIN followed by your new PIN.


